

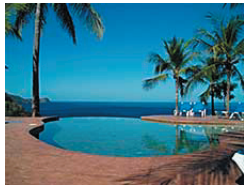


# DIVE SHOP

### El Ocotal, Costa Rica December 5-12, 2009

Dive shop, beach and dive boats only steps from your beachfront room. El Ocotal owns and operates the resort, the dive shop and the boats.



After five nights at El Ocotal, our trip is far from over. We go next to the Arenal Volcano Lodge, where we enjoy dinner at the Eco Thermals at Tabacon Hot Springs. The next day you take part in either a Sky Trek canopy or whitewater rafting excursion. Then we go to San Jose where we spend the night at the Double Tree Cariari before flying home.
