SCUBA Education in 2024 @ Harry's Dive Shop

1. Learning to scuba dive is about safety first - the fun follows.
2. *The Medical Questionnaire with all answers truthfully answered NO or a Physician's Written Approval is required prior to any in-water SCUBA instruction. (PA or NP not accepted in LA)*
3. Online academics must be completed prior to going to open water.
4. Be properly prepared to begin your class ON-TIME or reschedule with penalty.
5. Failure to show up or canceling class inside 24 hours is an automatic **forfeit** of tuition. **Rescheduling or makeup classes incur additional cost.**
6. ONLY those paying for class and filling out the student folder may get in the water. (If you are not part of the class, you do not get in the water.)
7. **Children 10 and 11** years old are limited to private lessons with a ratio of 2 kids to 1 Instructor. Though we will teach the young children, we cannot commit to certifying them in Florida.
8. **Children 12-17 (under 18)** must have a legal guardian sign the student folder.
9. You have **ONE YEAR** to complete ALL certification requirements from the date of initially signing the student folder. This includes open water dives. *Thereafter, you start from the beginning.*
10. *The initial, **unassisted** swimming requirements are **non-negotiable**.*
11. **Until certified**, student divers may only use SCUBA equipment from Harry's Dive Shop.
12. The plastic SCUBA diver certification card is available at additional cost.
13. We aim to create capable, confident divers making smart decisions. To achieve this goal, we promise to work with you until you are comfortable diving without professional guidance.
14. **No Money, No Place Saved** We cannot not hold space for an activity without money paid.
15. We send you the online academics **AFTER full payment of your SCUBA class.**
16. No refunds for unfinished classes.
17. When you purchase a weight integrated BC from us, we will buyback only your belt (**not lead**) provided you did not cut or write on it.
18. We CANNOT refund any equipment after it has been used.

From the date of signing the student folder, you have ONE YEAR to complete ALL requirements for SCUBA certification *including the dives in OPEN WATER*.

During the in-water orientation, fill out and sign the student folder, discuss available schedules, learn what is expected of you, exhibit your *swimming* abilities without assistance (no wetsuits, no goggles, no mask, no fins - just you and your swimsuit).

You will use **SCUBA in the shallow water**, learn what size BC fits best, how much lead you need to be neutrally buoyant and finally, use your personally provided mask, snorkel, scuba fins, booties and weighted belt to be sure they fit properly and are appropriate to serve your needs as a SCUBA diver in OPEN WATER.

It is designed to be fun yet has required skills, time and dive obligations.

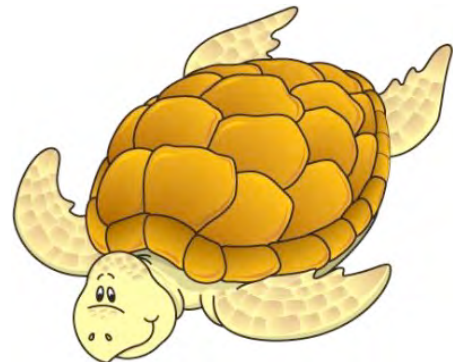
Our plans are to make 3+ dives in cool fresh spring water from shore
and 2 dives in the Gulf of Mexico from a boat.

Each diver provides mask, snorkel, SCUBA fins, boots, dive knife retrievable and usable with one hand, good whistle, personal SMB, underwater flashlight, *regulator with gauges and power inflator, *cold water wetsuit, *adequate lead *BC with alternate air source or separate octopus, dive computer and *2 full tanks each day. ****rentable***

Open Water Student divers may only use SCUBA equipment rented or purchased from Harry's Dive Shop until after certified.

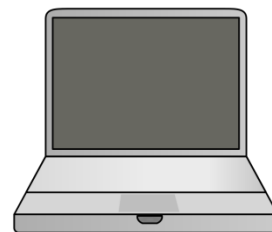

- When you pay in full for SCUBA class and provide your legal name, date of birth, physical address, email address and cell phone number, we can register you for class with SSI (*E-mail address is your user name.*)
- You will receive an email with a temporary password until you create your own. This expires in 24 hours. If you don't open it, call us for a reset.
- Complete your SCUBA course academics on the SSI approved **divessi.com**.
- Upon completion of the online academics, ***SIGN OUT*** from ALL DEVICES - both the app and website - so your work can be uploaded to show completion. *BTW, Chrome or Firefox work best.*

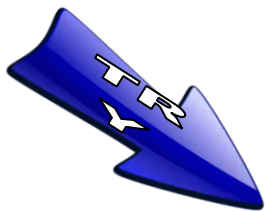

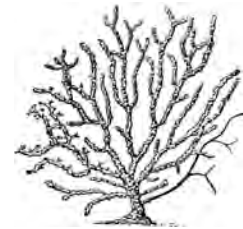

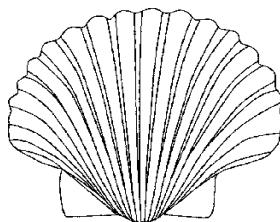

Limited Visibility

We plan and hope for great visibility on every dive, however, it is not always the reality we find. Limited visibility diving requires different skills. Taking this class is the best way to learn about and practice techniques needed to become a safer and more confident diver under challenging conditions. (Regard such dives as you would a scavenger hunt. Go slow and look carefully. After all, bigger marine life is present because of the smaller creatures). You are provided the knowledge and skills to more safely and comfortably dive in reduced visibility or the dark of night.

Underwater Navigation

Ever get turned around underwater and not know which way back to the line? It's stressful to realize your air supply and / or nitrogen uptake may not allow time to hunt for it. Eeeeeek!!!! Take the navigation course and become a better, more confident diver in challenging situations. Learn how to use a dive compass, apply natural navigation techniques, estimate distance, how to return to a designated point and basic navigation patterns. All of these learned skills improve dive safety and help you enjoy the dive.

Wreck Diving - Part I

In our geographic area, most dives are on wrecks of some sort. These impressive structures attract high densities of marine life, both large and small. Some wrecks provide divers the opportunity to immerse themselves in a degree of living history. The Wreck Diving specialty provides the skills and knowledge needed to become a safer and more confident diver. This class is a prerequisite for Advanced Wreck Diving.

Deep Diving

Many of the more exciting and intriguing dive sites are found in deeper water. Without proper training, this kind of diving can put you at risk. To plan dives properly, you should know how to prevent potential risks of deeper diving. This course provides information to make deep dives more comfortably and confidently. Remember, the deeper you are, the faster you go through your air. Don't cut a dive short because you didn't plan properly. We teach gas planning, computer use and getting the most from your deeper dives. This specialty is a prerequisite for some advanced training, making it an next logical step.

Some of the skills you demonstrate include but are not limited to....

- 600' surface swim in full scuba, configured for local diving conditions, non-stop and performed with relative ease (6 round trips in our pool)
- 150' underwater swim without mask
- Demonstrate proper pre-dive planning
- Plan dive based on personal air consumption rate
- Plan proper dive
- Properly execute the planned dive
- Equipment configuration appropriate for solo diving
- Proper descent/ascent rates
- Proper safety stop procedures
- Monitoring of decompression status: equipment, tables, computers, etc.
- Navigation skills - demonstrate proficiency of navigation with compass
- Demonstrate emergency change to redundant air supply (<100')
- Deploy SMB from 40'+ staying horizontal throughout
- Use of audible signaling device on surface and underwater

Two sessions in the pool followed by 2 dives in open water executing dives as planned.

Fee for open water dives is \$50/day plus the cost of the dive.

*With this certification, you should be permitted to continue diving
after other divers have ascended.*

WORDS of WISDOM

Having and wearing your own dive equipment is akin to sleeping in your own bed: Comfort, Familiar, Cleanliness, etc.

The answer to a problem underwater is not a choice,
it's a decision.

SCUBA equipment does nothing FOR the diver:
It is life-support equipment, *NOT life-saving* equipment.

The BC will *not help you float* unless you put air in it.

Regulators *will not breathe for you* and you certainly cannot get air from an empty tank.

DIVERS NEED TO PAY ATTENTION
and actively participate.

There is MUCH to learn and SCUBA certification is NOT the end all, know all, have all, etc . . . nor can it be purchased.
